Criteria for Selection and Service

Criteria of Selection

The Public Art Committee (PAC) shall serve as a standing committee of the Cultural Affairs Advisory Board (CAAB). The PAC shall consist of nine members appointed as follows: The Chair of the CAAB shall appoint three members to the PAC, from the CAAB, one of which shall be appointed as Chair. The additional six members will be appointed by the Chair of the CAAB from a list of qualified citizen candidates provided by the Museums and Cultural Affairs staff and approved by the CAAB. All PAC members must be qualified/credentialed professionals and represent the following:

Three members of the PAC shall be representatives of:

- Architecture
- Landscape Architecture
- Urban Planning
- Engineering
- Construction
- Development Industries

And the other three members of the PAC shall be representatives of:

- Visual Arts, such as visual artists (by means of a currently demonstrable record of exhibitions, work sold/collected and/ or commissioned).
- Curators
- Art historians
- Art critics
- Arts advocates/collectors or arts administrators.

Criteria for Service

The initial terms of the members shall be established under the PAC's established operating procedures. Members of the PAC shall be appointed to serve staggered terms from the date of appointment and are eligible to serve two-consecutive terms; after which a PAC member must sit out for one term before reappointment.

The Public Art Committee Members will:

Adopt rules and regulations for the governance and proceedings, which are not inconsistent with the charter or ordinances of the City of El Paso.

Not hold any public offices of honor trust or profit in the government of the City or County during their term of office.

Receive no compensation and shall have advisory powers only.
