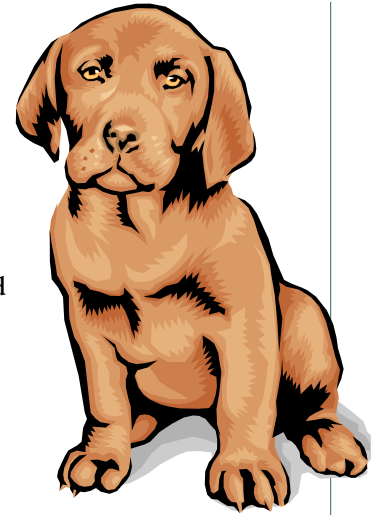

Your pet needs to be walked daily to be healthy.



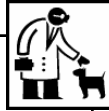
Your pet must visit a vet and get his vaccinations to keep them healthy!



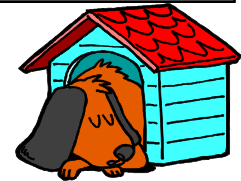
Your pet needs a comfortable place to sleep, to keep warm, or get away from the hot sun!
