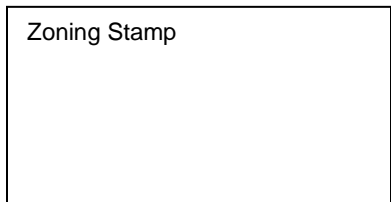

Applicant submits a Billiard Hall application for processing at the Development Services Department / Business Center, located at City Hall 5th floor, 2 Civic Center Plaza, El Paso, Texas 79901.

Business Center creates a license number and enters information from application and receives payment.

Applicant is issued a receipt and informed that application will be forwarded to the El Paso Police Department for record check and approval. The license will not be issued until approved application has been received from the El Paso Police Department.

Application is returned to the Development Services Department / Business Center by El Paso Police Department after it has either been approved or disapproved. Applicant is notified of application status.

If all required fees have been paid and the application has been approved, the license is issued.

RENEWAL

Business Center mail out renewal notices one month before license expires.

Applicant submits required payment in person or via mail.

Business Center clerk issues license and customer is issued and/or mailed license and receipt.
