

Adult immunizations:

Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR)	born during or after 1957
Chicken Pox (Varicella)	born after 1980 who are without evidence of immunity
Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)	ages 19 – 26
Shingles	60 years and older
Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B	19 years and older
Influenza	
Meningococcal	19 years and older
Typhoid	for travelers going out of the country
Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (TDAP)	11 - 64 years of age
Tetanus Diphtheria (TD)	7 - 10 years, 65 years
Pneumococcal	55 years and older

Infants and Children (up to 18 years of age):

Hepatitis B	birth
Diphtheria, Tetanus, Acellular Pertussis (DTAP)	2 months
Haemophilus influenzae type B (HIB)	2 months
Rotavirus	2 months, last dose by 8 months
Polio (Inactivated)	2 months
Hepatitis A	1 year
Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR)	1 year
Varicella	1 year
Pneumococcal	2 months
Influenza	6 months
Meningococcal	11 years (or as early as 2 - 10 years if high risk)
Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)	as early as 9 years
