Ciclovía 2008 – Street Closures

Please note the following street closures on the route:

- **Edgemere** will only have the two lanes closest to the linear park closed to allow for driveway access for abutting property owners.
- **Pebble Hills** will have one-way traffic (westbound only). Eastbound lanes will be closed. Eastbound traffic will be detoured to either Montwood or Edgemere between Yarbrough & Saul Kleinfeld.
- **Glengarry** will be closed completely.
- All other streets will allow limited access to local traffic only.

CICLOVIA 2008 : EAST
