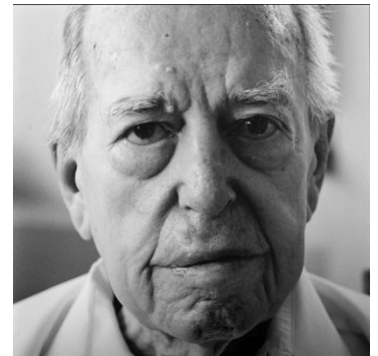

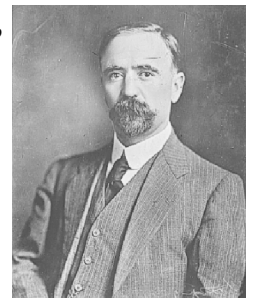


Francisco Agustin Villa Garcia, grandson of the famous Mexican revolutionary, will present an exhibit of photographs detailing the life of Pancho Villa.

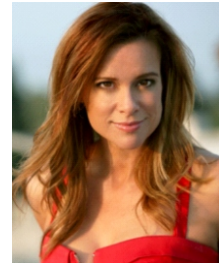

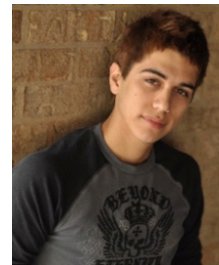

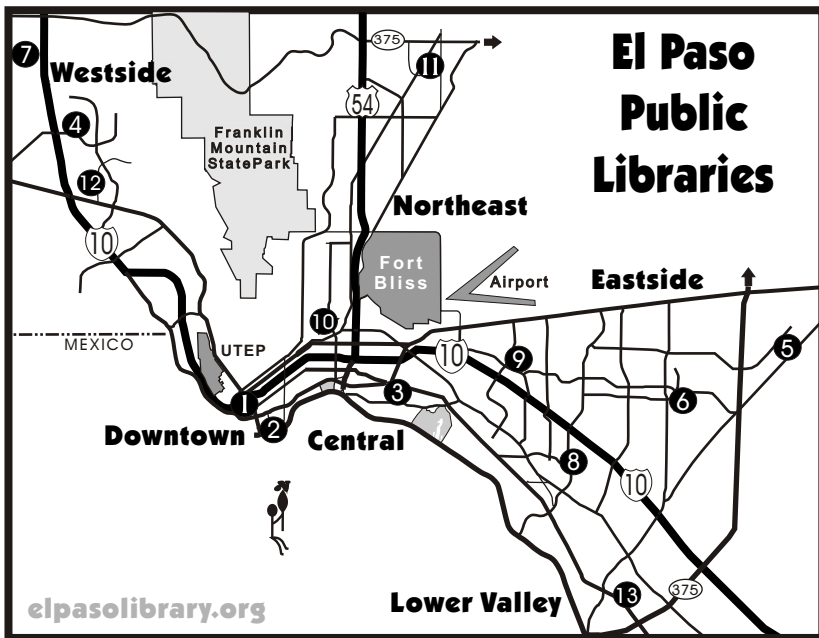
