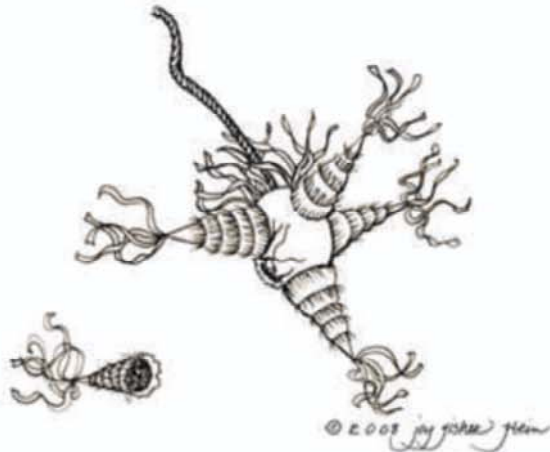

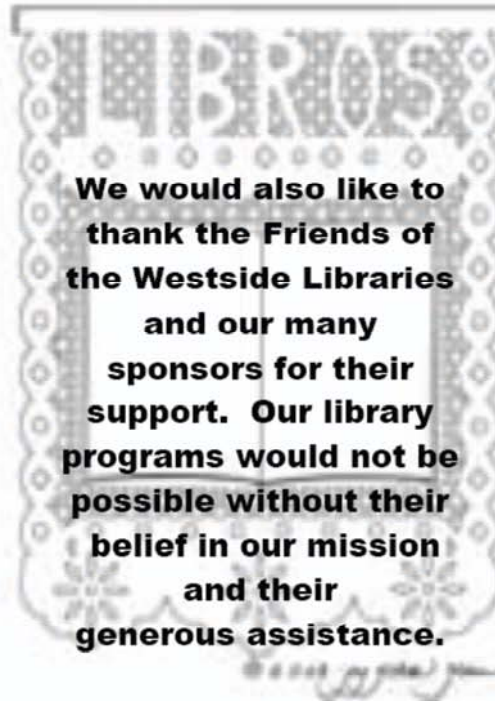

Summer Reading Club Rules

1. Registration begins Saturday, June 6 and ends July 11.
2. The last day to turn in reading logs is July 18. Certificates will be awarded on July 25
3. All children ages infants through age 12 are eligible for the Summer Reading Club. Children ages 13 or entering 7th grade must sign up for the Teen Summer Reading Club.
2. Show us your reading log every time you visit the library. We'd love to count the books/hours you've read.

Requirements to Receive a Certificate

- A. Each child may read a minimum of eight books or eight hours.
- B. Each child must record the book titles or hours read on the Reading Log and have a parent or guardian sign it.
- C. Participants should turn in their logs at the branch at which they registered.

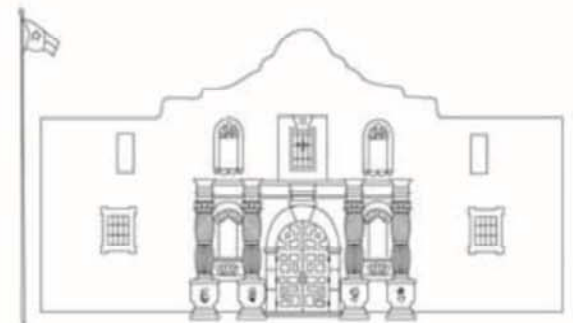
