One artwork will be exhibited at the El Paso Museum of Art and one will be exhibited the Museo de Arte in Juárez. All visual art media may be included in this exhibition.

Jurors

Ruth Fine

Curator of Special Projects in Modern Art at the National Gallery of Art, Washington, DC. Fine is the lead author of *Mark Rothko: The Works on Paper*, a multi-volume catalogue raisonné projected for publication by the National Gallery in 2010. As the curator of modern prints and drawings at the National Gallery from 1988 through 2002, Fine organized exhibitions of work by American artists including Helen Frankenthaler, Jasper Johns, Roy Lichtenstein, John Marin, and Georgia O'Keeffe.

Luis-Martin Lozano

Art Historian based in Mexico City. Lozano has written extensively about Mexican Modernism, focused on the work of Diego Rivera, Frida Kahlo, María Izquierdo and Remedios Varo among other Mexican masters of the 20th Century. A Fulbright scholar, Professor Lozano has been guest curator for all major museums in Mexico, and worked on projects with fine art museums in the U.S., Spain, Germany, Japan, Canada, Italy and recently China.

Eligibility

- The exhibition is open to all artists within the geographic area shown on the map (18 years or older).
- Entries must have been created within the last 12 months, and cannot have been exhibited in the last year.
- At least two works of art MUST be submitted.
- Entries must be original in concept, design, composition and execution. Artwork cannot have been created under the supervision of an instructor. Artwork must not be copied, in part or in whole, from any published/copyrighted work.
- The Jurors will be solely responsible for the content of the exhibition and the jury's decision will be final. Multiple entries of any artist may be accepted at the discretion of the Jurors.

*Employees of the City of El Paso are not eligible to participate in this competition.

Media

Artwork of the following media will be accepted, painting, sculpture, drawing, print making, photography, video, installation.

* No living animals or materials that do not meet the A.A.M. standards for collection management will be accepted

How to Enter

Guidelines

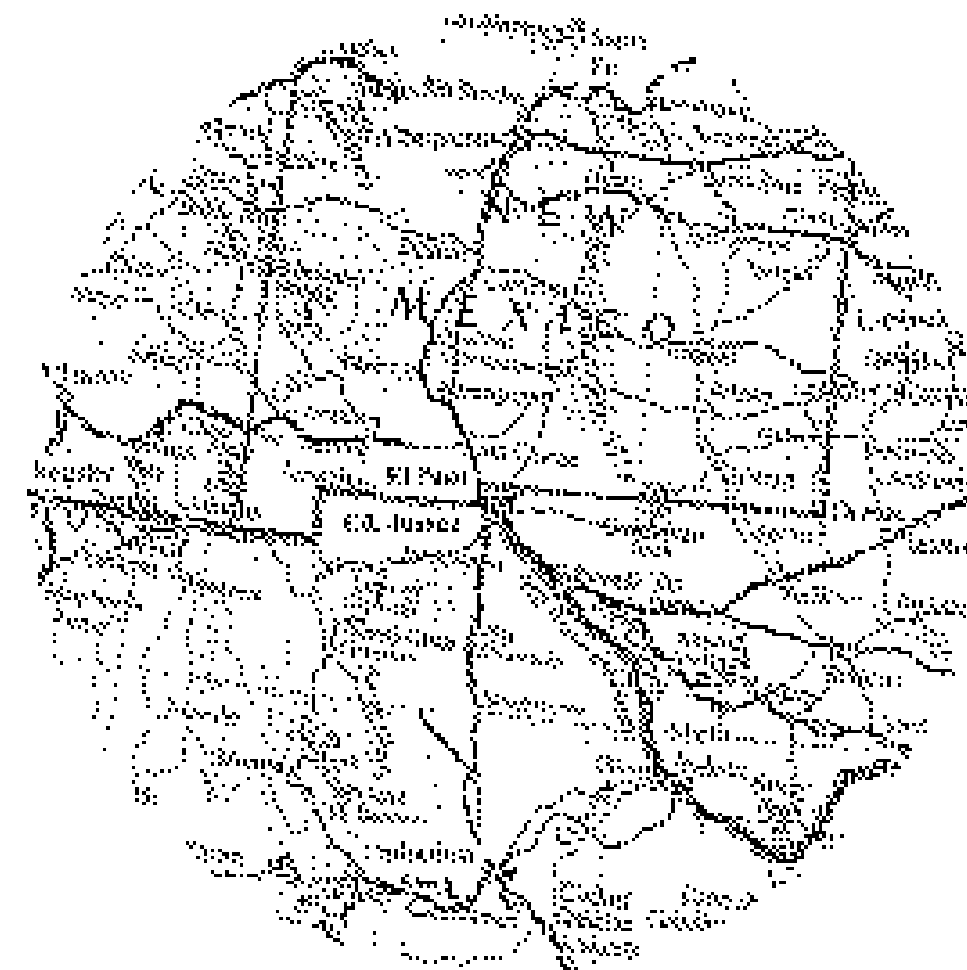
- Each blank for each entry must be filled-out so that the museum has all necessary information. Entries are limited to three works.
- Sculptures may not exceed a maximum weight of 150 pounds. 2D artworks may not be larger than 8'x 8'.
- All artwork must be ready for hanging.
- Installations may not be larger than 10'x14'X14', and are the responsibility of the artist to install.
- These rules and specifications will be strictly enforced.
- Mail entry materials to: Attn: Curatorial Staff, EPMA, One Arts Festival Plaza, El Paso, TX. 79901.

Digital Specifications

- JPEG file saved in PC format at a resolution of 300 dpi.
- Photographs should be cropped to show artwork only (no visible frames, or surroundings.)
- Each JPEG file must be named exactly as follows and in the following order: Artists initials, last name, title of entry (e.g. mcvidal_Untitled.jpg)
- For sculptures, include front and back views, labeled (e.g. mcvidalfront_untitled.jpg)
- Label both the CD and case (if any) with your full name, address, telephone number and titles of each of your entries.

Additional Information

- While the artist reserves all rights to the reproduction of the works, the artist consents to their use for education or PR purposes at the discretion of the exhibition committee.
- All artwork must be picked up from the museum on Sept. 15-19 2008. If not picked up by this time, a \$5.00 per day storage fee (per piece) will be assessed for each work.
- Artists with artwork accepted will receive delivery/shipping information. Shipping, delivery and return of the artwork is the responsibility of the artist.
