### **TEAM WORK BY NORTHEAST OFFICERS LEADS TO ARREST OF AGGRAVATED ROBBERY SUSPECT**

Location: 8901 Diana (Seven-Eleven)  
Arrested: Hector Valles RAMIREZ, 20 years of age, 5300 block of Pikes Peak

EL PASO, TEXAS – Team work by officers of the Northeast Regional Command leads to the arrest of a man responsible for an early morning aggravated robbery. At approximately 2:28a.m., Northeast patrol officers responded to an “Aggravated Robbery Just Occurred” call at the Seven-Eleven store located at 8901 Dyer. Upon arrival the officers learned that 20-year old Hector Valles Ramirez had walked into the store and threatened the clerk with a box cutter. Ramirez demanded money and fled the scene. Responding officers were able to obtain a good description of Ramirez and began to form a perimeter around the area. As a result, Ramirez was spotted by one of the assisting units at which time he fled from the officer in a brown Oldsmobile Delta 88. The officer lost sight of Ramirez, however other assisting units soon found the vehicle in a nearby area. The officers by finding the car soon were able to find Ramirez’s home and he was subsequently taken into custody. Detectives from the Crimes Against Persons Unit took over the investigation and Ramirez was booked into the El Paso County Jail charged with Aggravated Robbery (First Degree Felony) and Evading Arrest and or Detention in a Motor Vehicle (State Jail Felony). His bond is set at \$18,500. No injuries were reported in this incident.
