CHILD KIDNAPPED THIS AFTERNOON

EL PASO, TEXAS – The El Paso Police Department continues the search for 3 year old Jaylin Marie Talamantes, who was abducted from her father's home. At approximately 9p.m., a Local Amber Alert was issued by the El Paso Police Department for Jayline. Jayline was taken by force from her father's home at 447 S. Schutz in El Paso's Mission Valley. The abduction took place just before five on the afternoon of January 30, 2008. At that time, 25-year old Daniel Escobar forced his way into the home of Jayline's father and physically assaulted Jayline's stepmother and took Jayline from her stepmother's arms. Escobar fled the scene with Jayline's biological mother, 23-year old Monica Iglesias. Due to the violence in the incident, a local amber alert continues in effect. The El Paso Police Department requested the activation of a statewide alert, however the circumstances in this case do not meet the State's criteria and the activation of a statewide alert was denied. Local law enforcement agencies, do have the authority to activate local and regional alerts, which is what the El Paso Police Department did. Arrest warrants were issued for both Iglesias and Escobar for the First Degree Felony of Burglary of Habitation related to this incident. Due to the fact that custody has not been granted to either parent, both have legal custody of the child. This means that this case does not meet the elements for the charge of Kidnapping. Escobar is described as a Hispanic male, black hair, 6'2" in height, 230lbs., dark complexion, and last seen wearing blue jeans, a blue sweater with a white and red strips across the chest. Iglesias is described as a Hispanic Female, black or



brown hair, light complexion, 5'2" in height, 130lbs., and was last seen wearing an orange shirt with blue jeans. The subjects left in a charcoal gray, 4 door Ford F-150 pickup truck. It is believed that the suspect may be in route to Borger, Texas which is in the area of Amarillo. Anyone having any information the whereabouts of Jayline should call 911 or 832-4400.
