

After School Program

Registration for the El Paso Parks and Recreation After School Program is at specific school sites with the El Paso and Ysleta School Districts and at the Recreation Centers for Parks and Recreation. The free program has two registration periods, September - December, and January - June.



Ages for the program are 6-12 and the actual time of the program varies in accordance with each of the School Districts calendars. Activities throughout the year include structured programs for youth development and community leaders that partake as guest speakers.
