## State of Texas Federal Disaster Declaration Fact Sheet

August 15, 2006

On August 15, 2006, President Bush declared a major disaster for the State of Texas, triggering the release of Federal funds to help people and communities recover from the impacts of flooding beginning July 31, 2006, and continuing. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows.

Incident: Flooding

Incident Period: July 31, 2005, and continuing

Type of Assistance: Hazard Mitigation: (Assistance to State and local governments and certain private nonprofit organizations for actions taken to prevent or reduce long-term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

Designated Counties: El Paso County in the State of Texas is eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER: Additional designations may be made at a later date after further evaluation.
