Sun Metro Detours Routes for High School Parades

El Paso, Texas—Three high school homecoming parades will require Sun Metro to detour several routes on Thursday, Sept. 24 and Wednesday, Sept. 30.

The detours are expected to last between one or two hours. Sun Metro drivers will make courtesy stops along the detoured routes as required.

Del Valle Homecoming Detour

Route 66:

Beginning at 4 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 24, buses traveling outbound, north on Bordeaux Drive will turn left onto Iberia Road, which becomes Morelia Road, left onto Warwick Road, right onto North Loop Drive returning to the regular route.

Franklin Homecoming Detour

Route 14:

Beginning at 4 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 24, buses traveling outbound, north on Westwind Drive will turn right onto Redd Road, left onto High Ridge Drive, left onto Resler Drive, right onto Belvidere Street returning to the regular route.

Buses traveling inbound, east on Belvidere Street will turn left onto Westwind Drive, right onto Redd Road, left onto High Ridge Drive, left onto Resler Drive, left onto Belvidere Street, right onto Westwind Drive returning to the regular route.

Route 17:

Buses traveling outbound, east on Lakehurst Road will turn left onto Mary Stuart Drive, left onto Royal Arms Drive, left onto Bristol Drive, right onto Lakehurst Road, right onto Thorn Avenue, left onto Redd Road returning to the regular route.

Bel Air Homecoming Detour

Route 63:

Begin at about 4:45 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 30, buses traveling outbound, south on Giles Road will turn left onto N. Carolina Drive, right onto Lilac Way, left onto

Buses traveling inbound, west on Glendale Avenue will turn left on Lafayette Drive, right onto Mauer Drive, right onto Lilac Way, right onto Rancho Alegre Way, left onto N. Carolina Drive, right onto Giles Road returning to the regular route.

Route: 65:

Buses traveling outbound, south on Lilac Way will turn left onto Mauer Drive, left onto Lafayette Drive, right onto Yermoland Drive returning to the regular route.

Buses traveling inbound, west on Yermoland Drive will turn left on Lafayette Drive, right onto Mauer Drive, right onto Lilac Way, right onto Rancho Alegre Way returning to the regular route.

Route 67:

Buses traveling outbound, north on Yarbrough Drive will turn right onto Lafayette Drive, right onto Gateway East Boulevard, left onto Lomaland Drive, left onto Gateway West Boulevard, right onto Yarbrough Drive returning to the regular route.

Buses traveling inbound, south on Yarbrough Drive will turn left onto Gateway East Boulevard, right onto Lafayette Drive, left onto Yarbrough Drive returning to the regular route.

A shuttle van will provide transportation along portions of the routes impacted by the Bel Air Homecoming parade.
