### **Sun Metro Announces Service Improvements**

El Paso, Texas — **Beginning this Sunday, Nov. 15, Sun Metro will make several service improvements to include minor scheduling modifications to six (6) routes, one route extension and a boarding change.**

Route 62 (Pasodale via Lakeside) will extend its service to the new Bert Williams Downtown Santa Fe Transfer Center (DTC). It will be using Bay 5.

Route 35 (Northgate via Dyer) will move from Boarding Bay 8 to Bay 7 at the DTC.

The changes to the following routes are due to extended service improvements experienced in September:

**ROUTE 9 GOLDEN HORSESHOE DOWNTOWN CIRCULATOR** recently absorbed Route 8. The route remains FREE to the public. The changes to the Monday-Sunday schedule account for Downtown traffic congestion.

**ROUTE 25 UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER** was recently extended and will be adjusted to improve the efficiency for the Monday-Sunday schedule.

**ROUTE 33 GOVERNMENT HILLS VIA BASSETT PLACE** recently extended its service to include the DTC with express service to the Robert E. McKee Five Points Transit Terminal. Adjustments will be made to the Monday-Saturday schedule to improve the efficiency and address Downtown traffic congestion.

**ROUTE 34 MEDICAL CENTER VIA CLIFF** expanded its service to include the Robert E. McKee Five Points Transit Terminal from the Medical Center area. Adjustments to the Monday-Friday schedule will improve route efficiency.

**ROUTE 35 NORTHGATE/DYER** will experience adjustments in the Monday-Saturday schedules to account for Downtown traffic congestion.

**ROUTE 50 MONTANA** will experience adjustments to the Monday-Saturday schedules to account for Downtown traffic congestion and recent route changes.
