# COMMUNITY MEETING

The City of El Paso's Streets and Maintenance Department has scheduled a community meeting to inform the public of plans to install bike lanes along High Ridge from Westside Community Park to Via Serena Drive. The project scope includes the restriping of the existing roadway to include the removal of one lane of traffic in each direction to accommodate the bike lanes along High Ridge Drive.



The project is part of the City of El Paso's Comprehensive Bike Plan. The Bike Plan was developed by City Staff and experts from Alta Planning + Design – one of the most experienced bicycle planning firms in the nation. The plan incorporates over a year of community feedback and input from stakeholders, which included five community meetings, two open houses, and numerous meetings held by the Bicycle Advisory Committee. To ensure synergy, the planning process included close coordination with agencies undertaking bicycle planning efforts, including the Texas Department of Transportation and the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization.

The Bike Plan serves as a guide in identifying which routes are best for bicycling in order to create an interconnected network of bicycle lanes, which will allow bicyclists to commute from one side of town to another using only bike lanes.
