The City of El Paso's Capital Improvement Department in conjunction with the Office of City Representative Dr. Michiel R. Noe of District 5, has scheduled an open house community meeting to inform the public of the Eastside Transfer Center project.

The facility, which will be constructed at 12781 Edgemere Boulevard in East El Paso, will include the following amenities and services:

- A new Transit Terminal Building
- Waiting areas, drivers lounge, public and family restrooms, concessionaire, vending areas, IT/electrical rooms and a community room
- Bus bays for both local route and RTS
- A park and ride parking lot

The total budget for the design and construction of the Eastside Transfer Center is approximately \$5 million, and is part of the City of El Paso's commitment to enhance the El Paso's comprehensive regional transportation system
