The City of El Paso’s Capital Improvement Department in conjunction with the Office of City Representative Peter Svarzbein of District 1 invites the public to a community meeting to learn more about the proposed Sunset Terrace Hike and Bike Trail.

The proposed project supports the development of the Sunset Terrace Trail, a pedestrian and bicycle corridor just west of Berringer Street between La Puerta Drive and Bells Corner Avenue. The new pathway will include the trees, vegetation, new lighting, benches, bike racks, trash receptacles, ADA compliant ramps and pet waste stations. The corridor will provide connectivity to several existing neighborhood.



This \$300,000 project is funded by a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and is part of the City’s commitment to improve El Paso’s regional comprehensive transportation system.
