



PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
City of El Paso Bicycle Connectivity Project
Phase I
El Paso County, Texas
CSJ: 0924-06-542

The City of El Paso will be conducting a public hearing on proposed roadway enhancements for bicycles. The City is proposing to restripe the existing roadways to accommodate bicycle lanes and improve bicyclist mobility in various locations. The locations of improvements would include:

- Resler Drive from north of Belvidere Street to south of Enid Court
- Robinson Avenue from west of Oregon Street to Virginia Street
- Los Angeles Drive from Oregon Street to Rio Grande Avenue
- Alabama Street from Grant Avenue to north of Atlas Avenue
- Fort Boulevard from Alabama Street to Dyer Street
- Viscount Boulevard from Montwood Drive to the Interstate Highway 10 (I-10) westbound frontage road



The total project length would be approximately 8.4 miles and would be constructed within the existing right-of-way (ROW). The hearing will take place on **Wednesday, May 15, 2019** with an open house starting at **6 p.m.** and the formal presentation commencing at **7p.m.** The hearing will be held at the Multipurpose Recreation Center, **9031 Viscount Blvd, El Paso, Texas 79925.**

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve bicyclist mobility in the project area. The project would not require the acquisition of additional ROW. No residential or commercial displacements would occur. The proposed project is not anticipated to impact any waters of the U.S. or floodplains.

The purpose of the hearing is to provide information and gather input from the public on the proposed project. Persons interested in attending the public hearing with special communication or accommodation needs should contact the City of El Paso Public Information Office, Russel Williams at (915) 212-1079 at least five (5) working days before the hearing. The hearing will be conducted in English, but Spanish translation will be available if needed. The City will make all reasonable efforts to accommodate special needs as requested.

Maps of the project study area and layouts of the project, as well as environmental documents will be available for review and comment during the hearing. Project staff will be available to answer questions. The same information will also be available for review 15 days prior to the hearing at the City of El Paso Capital Improvement Department Office, 218 N. Campbell Street, 2nd Floor, El Paso, TX 79901.

Verbal and written comments from the public regarding this project are encouraged. Comments may be submitted either at the public hearing or within 15 days after the hearing.
