The City of El Paso's Museums and Cultural Affairs Department and the Capital Improvement Department will host a community meeting to discuss the public art component for the Airway Blvd Median Improvements Project. The meeting will be held on Wednesday, December 12, at 6 p.m. in the La Placita Conference Room at the El Paso International Airport, 6701 Convaire. Parking will be validated.

Christopher Weed, Colorado Springs, Colorado, uses luminous and tactile materials to create abstract and organic shapes that draw the viewer nearer. His monumental sculptures transform the idea of ordinary objects into the extraordinary. His purpose is to overwhelm the observer using size, variation and multiplicity of elements. The intent is not to shock, but to inspire a sense of awe that takes the viewer to another place, if even for a brief moment. Christopher graduated with a BFA from the University of Maryland, studying two years in Germany. He has completed over 35 permanent public art installations since 1998, to include university settings, to bridges over protected wetlands and light rail stations. His work can be found in museums and private/corporate collections in the US and abroad.

The City has contracted with a consulting firm to develop Median and Parkway Landscape improvements including irrigation and safety lighting. The design encompasses six corridors including the Airway Boulevard: I-10 to Airport Road. The new landscape design will complement the existing streets, medians and sidewalks. The project enhances the aesthetics as drivers and pedestrians travel through the corridors. Other nearby landscaped corridors were reviewed for inspiration and consistency. The Airway Corridor improvements are directly into the EPIA Landscape Architecture project.
