The City of El Paso Museums and Cultural Affairs Department's (MCAD) will host a public meeting on Thursday, December 19, at 6 p.m. at the El Paso Museum of History, to discuss the public art piece that will be installed in the roundabout at N. El Paso Street and E. San Antonio Avenue in downtown El Paso.

Colorado artist Christopher Weed, the selected artist for the project, will present his preliminary design and solicit feedback from attendees. He uses luminous and tactile materials to create abstract and organic shapes that draw the viewer nearer. His monumental sculptures transform the idea of ordinary objects into the extraordinary.

The roundabout will be constructed as part of a project to improve traffic flow and connectivity along El Paso Street. In addition to the new roundabout, the City will install lighted bollards, painted cross walks, street furniture and other amenities to improve the aesthetics along El Paso Street.
