The park is located 900 Rim Road. The repairs will stabilize the slopes at the southernmost end of the park overlooking Schuster Avenue, and includes new sidewalk, landscaping, public art.

The stabilization project may incorporate a public art component.

This project with a total budget of approximately \$5.2 million is funded from the 2018 Capital Plan, and is part of the City of El Paso's commitment to public safety and maintaining city facilities.
