Greater El Paso Landfill, Citizen Collection Stations to Close Early Due to Wind, Low Visibility

EL PASO, Texas – The Greater El Paso Landfill and the Citizen Collection Stations (CCS) are closing early today to ensure the safety of customers and employees due to the persistent high winds and low visibility.

The landfill and the collection stations closed at 1 p.m. and will resume normal operating hours tomorrow, March 14, 2019 should weather permit.

The Greater El Paso Landfill is normally open from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday. The Citizen Collection Stations are located at 4501 Hondo Pass, 121 Atlantic, 1034 Pendale, and 3510 Confederate. Their normal operating hours are 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
