Public Invited to Workshop for Main Library Renovation

WHO: City of El Paso Capital Improvement Department

WHAT: **Public Workshop**

WHERE: **Main Library (Maud Sullivan Auditorium), 501 N. Oregon in downtown**

WHY: The City of El Paso Departments of Capital Improvement and Public Libraries invite the public to a workshop to share their thoughts on the renovation concepts for the Main Library in downtown.

The improvements are part of the first phase of a project to deliver on the voter-approved Mexican American Cultural Center (MACC), a signature project of the 2012 Quality of life Bond program.

This project is currently under design and includes renovations to approximately 60,000 square feet of the existing library.

All of the library's existing services such as Teen Town, Adult Education Spaces, Children's Library, Border Heritage will all be retained or enhanced under the library renovation. The reconfiguration and reprogramming of some of the existing library spaces will be necessary as part of this renovation project.

This project is part of the City of El Paso's commitment to enhance the quality of life for residents, business and visitors.
