## **Greater El Paso Landfill, Drop-Off Sites**

*Closed to Residents due to High Winds, Low Visibility*

**EL PASO, Texas** – The Environmental Services (ESD) will be closing the Great El Paso Landfill and all Citizen Collection Stations (CCS) effective immediately to the general public due to the low visibility and high winds.

The landfill at 2300 Darrington Road and CCS locations will be close to ensure the safety of ESD customers and employees due to the weather.

The landfill will resume normal operating hours on Thursday, April 11 should weather permit. The Greater El Paso Landfill is normally open from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Citizen Collections Station will resume normal operating hours Wednesday. The CCS is normally open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday.
