Citizen Collection Station on Delta Drive to Close

EL PASO, Texas – Effective March 28, 2015, the City's Environmental Service Department (ESD) will permanently close its Citizen Collection Station located at **4200 Delta Drive**. Customers of this station are asked to use one of the four other stations located throughout the city. The nearest station to the affected site is located at 2492 Harrison Avenue.

The closure of the collection station will allow El Paso Water Utilities (EPWU) to relocate its current operations on 130 N. Cotton Street to the collection station property on Delta. This change is needed to make way for the relocation of the Rescue Mission of El Paso at the water utilities property.

The Citizen Collection Stations are open Tuesday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. and are conveniently located at the following addresses:

- 121 Atlantic (West)

- 2492 Harrison (Central)
