ARREST MADE IN CONNECTION TO APARTMENT FIRE

EL PASO, Texas – An arson of habitation investigation from the El Paso Fire Marshal’s Office has led to the arrest of Angelica Salazar in connection to an apartment fire on February 12, 2019, at the 9000 block of Dyer St. Investigators from the Fire Marshal’s office apprehended Angelica Salazar on Tuesday, February 12, 2019, at approximately 3:05 PM.

According to the Fire Department Investigators, Salazar intentionally ignited a fire using gasoline inside of the apartment; damaging clothes and furniture in the living room area. The fire was quickly contained by EPFD’s Pumper 16 crews. No injuries were reported.

Salazar was taken into custody and booked into the El Paso County Jail. She is being charged with violation of the Texas Penal Code Offense 28.02 – Arson; First Degree Felony with a \$25,000 bond.
