Free Flu Vaccines to the Uninsured Vaccinations for Health program to host five clinics in January

EL PASO, Texas – The El Paso Fire Department is encouraging the community to take advantage of the popular Vaccinations for Health program. Vaccinations for Health provides free influenza, blood pressure and glucose screenings to patients 18 and older, and pneumonia vaccines to those 65 and older.
