Las Cruces Woman Charged with False Report and Perjury

El PASO, Texas – Officers assigned to the El Paso Police Department’s Auto Theft Task Force have arrested and charged a Las Cruces woman with False Report and Perjury. The investigation revealed that 21-year old Khadijah SENA contacted El Paso Police and filed a report that her 2013 Dodge Dart had been stolen on 08/13/2017 at 7:36 a.m. Further investigation revealed that SENA had contacted police for assistance at 2:38 a.m., on 08/13/2017 as she was in new freeway construction area, in a vehicle, and covered with dirt. SENA later told officers that her vehicle has been stolen from 200 Cincinnati and filed a report. Auto Theft investigators determined that the vehicle had been involved in a collision and was located in a construction zone area at 700 Executive Center in a dirt pile. Auto Theft investigators determined that the vehicle was not stolen and secured arrest warrants for SENA for the offenses of False Report to a Peace Officer and Perjury. SENA was booked into the El Paso County Jail for the listed warrants. Her bonds totaled \$4,000.00.
