UPDATE NE Tactical Arrest and Charge Fourth Man in Mesquite Hills Neighborhood Vehicle Burglary

EL PASO, Texas – The El Paso Police Department’s Northeast Tactical Unit has arrested a fourth man in the on-going investigation of Burglary of Vehicle cases in the Mesquite Hills Neighborhood of Northeast El Paso. Investigators arrested 20-year old Carlos Adrian MARQUEZ on Saturday, October 6, 2018 on an outstanding warrant for Burglary of Vehicle regarding this case. He was booked on a bond of \$2,500.00. This investigation continues.

El Paso, TX -Officers assigned to the El Paso Police Department’s Northeast Tactical unit have arrested and charged three Northeast El Paso men with Burglary of Vehicle after a September 6 – 7, 2018 case. Northeast patrol officers responded to a call that several vehicles had been burglarized during the listed dates and times. The Northeast Tactical unit assisted with the investigation and as a result, identified 18-year old Sky Michael Estrada AMATO, 20-year old Virgil Jay LEON, and 18-year old Isaiah SAMBRANO as the individuals involved. Investigators learned that the three had worked together to enter vehicles, not theirs and remove property. AMATO, LEON, and SAMBRANO have been arrested and charged with Burglary of Vehicle (Bond \$5,000.00 each) in this case. AMATO, LEON, and SAMBRANO were booked into the El Paso County Jail on the Burglary of Vehicle charges.
