## **Two Arrested After SWAT Responds to Northeast El Paso on Shots Fired Call**

Date & Time: Wednesday, October 10, 2018 @ 3:20 A.M.  
Location: 7500 block Howard  
Arrested 1: Female  
Arrested 2: Male

**EL PASO, Texas** – Officers assigned to the El Paso Police Department’s Northeast Patrol responded to a “shots fired” call at 3:25 A.M., Wednesday morning at a residence in the 7500 block of Howard. Officers arrived and found a victim (male) who had arrived at a residence in the 7500 block of Howard, in his vehicle (White 2007 Dodge Durango), when he and the vehicle were shot at several times. The victim was inside the vehicle and was not hit by the rounds. The vehicle was struck several times. Northeast Officers were able to secure the residence and the immediate neighborhood. The El Paso Police Department’s Crisis Management Team and SWAT were called for assistance. After several hours, a female from the residence exited the home. The female was found to be in possession of illegal narcotics (Methamphetamine) and was placed under arrest. A few hours later, the male resident exited the home. Crimes Against Persons investigators have identified this male as the individual that discharged a shotgun at the victim and his vehicle. The male was placed under arrest and is being charged with Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon. The names and mug shots of the two people arrested in the incident will be released upon completion of the formal booking process. This investigation continues.
