58th Traffic Fatality

Special Traffic Investigators continue their investigation into yesterday morning's single-vehicle collision that claimed the life of another El Pasoan. The preliminary investigation indicated an unknown male was westbound at the 800 block of E. Cliff Dr. when he lost control of a 2003 Ford Expedition and collided with a rock wall. The driver fled the scene on foot, leaving his mortally wounded passenger behind. 31 –year old April Pedroza succumbed to her injuries and was pronounced dead on the scene. The investigation is on-going at this time and charges are pending against the driver. This is the 58th traffic fatality of 2020, compared to 50 this time last year.
