Fingerprinting Services Available at Police Department

EL PASO, TEXAS: The El Paso Police Department's Records Division will be providing the service of fingerprinting for the purpose of identification beginning Monday, May 22, 2017. Individuals requesting this service must provide a valid State or Federal identification, such as a driver's license, military ID, passport or birth certificate with a second form of photo identification. This service will be available at the Northeast Regional Command Center located at 9600 Dyer, only. The hours of operation are from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. This office opens at 8:00 a.m., and closes at 1:00 p.m., on the last Wednesday of the month. There will be a fee \$10.00 per card requested and the Department will provide the cards for this service. Payments accepted are cash and check only.
