Dear Resident,

The City's Street and Maintenance Department, in conjunction with City Representative Henry Rivera's office, and through its Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP), has programmed changes to Janway Drive, between Springwood and Schwood, to address concerns such as speeding, accidents and cut-through traffic.

The NTMP was adopted by the City of El Paso to evaluate traffic patterns in residential neighborhoods and, where applicable, recommend and install traffic calming solutions. Through an NTMP application process initiated by your neighborhood, Janway Drive was deemed eligible for traffic calming improvements in May 2018.

Until recently, limited funding had prevented the City from moving forward with traffic calming on Janway Drive. In August 2019, City Council authorized funding that allowed staff to purchase speed cushions to address many of the streets on the waiting list, including Janway Drive.

The City will be hosting a public meeting at the Eastwood Heights Elementary School cafeteria (10530 Janway) at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, November 19, 2019. This meeting will include a presentation of the proposed speed cushion locations, as well as, a tentative installation schedule. *Please note that our policy requires that final locations for speed cushions be coordinated with abutting property owners prior to installation.*

If you have any questions or concerns, those items can be discussed with City staff at the public meeting.
