1. What's a construction budget you guys have in mind?

Approximately 3.5 M.

2. I was wondering if you already have concept designs for this corridor.

No concepts have been proposed. Scope includes a road diet and multimodal pedestrian facilities.

3. I know you said to letting in 2027. Is there an anticipated quarter in 2027 that you all are targeting?

Goal is to let this project in February of 2027.

4. Is there going to be consideration for future extending limits from Kenworthy Down to potentially McCombs?

Not with this project.

The key project objectives reference street illumination; however, this item is not listed within the scope of services. Could you please confirm whether this omission is intentional and, if applicable, provide clarification regarding the scope for street illumination

Project includes street illumination.

5. We want to confirm that the City of El Paso & CID does not allow a Flip/Flop (flipping) on this RFQ submittal; where two firms team up and make two separate submittals: Firm A submits as a Prime with Firm B as one of their Subconsultants, and, simultaneously Firm B submits as a Prime with Firm A as one of their Subconsultant
