Dear Ms. Prine,

This letter is in response to your email of June 10<sup>th</sup> providing with the more detailed requirements to the City's Lobbyist Reporting process. The following information reflects the specific issues that I have addressed with City employees and elected officials during the first quarter of 2021.

Senior Deputy City Manager Cary Westin - all our communications were conducted by telephone or the use of MS Teams. We spoke on several occasions regarding economic development efforts to grow the presence of defense contractors' presence in the region. I arranged for Mr. Westin to join Raytheon executives visiting the city for lunch to discuss future opportunities.

In separate conversations, I briefed Mr. Westin about the ongoing efforts to work with FEMA regarding the proposed flood plain mapping process and its potential affects on property owners, property values and tax revenue implications. I also briefed him on the work that the City's Planning and Inspections Department is doing in coordination with FEMA, EPWU, the USIBWC (International Boundary and Water Commission) and El Paso County.

City Representative Peter Svarzbein – we discussed the FEMA flood plain mapping process and assisted with providing information from FEMA for his virtual Town Hall meeting with District 1 constituents.

City Representative Joe Molinar – met with him virtually to introduce him to two multi family housing developers that are doing projects in his district. No requests were made. Introductions and informational only.

El Paso International Airport Management – Sam Rodriguez, Terry Sharpe and Suzan Aguilar – Discuss the possible interests of EPIA to develop a lease agreement with my client who is interested in becoming a concessionaire.

Mark Weber, Community Development – To encourage beginning to have meetings of the Housing Task Force which had been placed on indefinite hold by the City due to COVID restrictions.

Mayor Leeser and Chief of Staff Estrella Escobar - met to discuss economic development strategies for the City and future concepts to engage the local business community to assist. Ongoing meetings on monthly basis.
