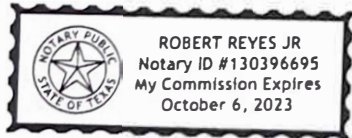

Dear Ms. Marquez:

This letter is to advise you of an overdue lobbyist activity report. On March 7, 2006, the City Council of El Paso enacted Ordinance 016300, regarding City Code Chapter 2.94 governing the registration and reporting requirements of lobbyists. Under City Code, Section 2.94.070, there is a requirement for lobbyists to file a quarterly report of lobbying activity with the City Clerk's Office. If the lobbyist has no activity to report, he/she is required to file with the City Clerk a written statement notifying there is no activity or changes to report.

Our records in the City Clerk's Office reflect that you became a registered lobbyist on November 29, 2022. A

quarterly report or a letter notifying us of no activity to report for April 1, 2023, through June 30, 2023, was due by **July 10, 2023**. We have not received the report or a written statement from you.

Please submit the report or a written statement to my office for the above reporting periods. Under City Code 2.94.120, the penalty for knowingly or intentionally lobbying in violation of a provision of Chapter 2.94 or intentionally failing to meet the reporting provisions is a misdemeanor, which can result in a fine of up to \$500 under City Code 1.08.010. If you have questions regarding the reporting requirement, you may review the ordinance online at:



You may email the form to our office at CityClerk@elpasotexas.gov as long as it has been notarized. You may also file in person at the City Clerk's Office from Monday through Thursday, 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM, closed on Friday.
