Notice of Proposed Amendment to 2019-2020 Annual
Action Plan of 2015-2020 Consolidated Plan



The City of El Paso's Department of Community and Human Development (DCHD) proposes to amend the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan of the 2015-2020 Consolidated Plan by making the following changes to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG):

Reduce: City of El Paso, Financial Counseling and Bankability Program; 801 Texas Ave, El Paso TX 79901 — \$112,500: proposed reduction of this program by \$112,500 allows for allocation of these funds to an El Paso Public Libraries Internet Accessibility Program. Following reduction, revised program budget for Financial Counseling and Bankability Program will be \$137,500.

Add: El Paso Public Libraries, Wi-Fi Accessibility Program; 501 N Oregon St, El Paso, Texas 79901 — \$112,500: Funding from the Financial Counseling and Bankability project is proposed to be redistributed to an El Paso Public Libraries Wi-Fi Accessibility Program for the purchase of 625 mobile hotspots including 9-months of internet service for those hotspots. The hotspots will be issued to households of low to moderate income that do not have internet access at home, allowing household members to work remotely, attend school, etc. during the response to, and recovery from, COVID-19.
