Notice of Proposed Amendment to 2019-2020 Annual
Action Plan of 2015-2020 Consolidated Plan



The City of El Paso’s Department of Community and Human Development (DCHD) proposes to amend the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan of the 2015-2020 Consolidated Plan by making the following changes to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG):

Reduce: City of El Paso, “placeholder project”; 801 Texas Ave, El Paso, Texas 79901—\$341,160 — A “placeholder project” was established for the remaining unallocated balance of CDBG-CV Phase III. Recommendation to reduce this “project” by \$341,160 will allow for completion of funding for the Inspira Hotel Emergency Shelter Program. Remaining balance for “placeholder project” will be \$2,680,181.

Increase: Endeavors, Inspira Hotel Emergency Shelter Program; 7815 N Mesa St, El Paso, Texas 79932 — \$341,160: In addition to the already budgeted \$1.1 million CDBG-CV, recommendation for additional funding will allow for operation of the project for four full months.

Add: Rapid Rehousing Program; El Paso, Texas — \$1,700,000: ESG-CV funds are recommended to fund a program that will rapidly rehouse individuals who are experiencing homelessness.

Add: Emergency Shelter Program; El Paso, Texas — \$500,000: ESG-CV funds are recommended to support emergency shelter operations in the community.

Add: Homeless Prevention Program, El Paso, Texas — \$430,000: ESG-CV funds are recommended to fund homeless prevention services to include rental assistance.

Add: Street Outreach Program; El Paso, Texas — \$100,000: ESG-CV funds are recommended to fund street outreach activities for unsheltered homeless individuals.

Add: Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) Program; El Paso, Texas—\$234,248: ESG-CV funds are recommended to be used to bolster HMIS reporting.

Add: Homeless Welcome Center Program; El Paso, Texas — \$1,000,000: ESG-CV funds are recommended to be used to create a Homeless Welcome Center Program.
