

Neighborhood Cleanup Program Purpose

 Keep our neighborhoods clean, safe and beautiful for all residents to enjoy.

 Be strategic with cleanup resources in addressing beatification efforts.

 Provide support to areas prone to illegal dumping and vulnerable populations who may require cleanup assistance.

Nurture community partnerships and promote volunteerism.



Program Summary

- Award up to eight cleanup projects, one per City District.
- City-recognized Neighborhood Associations are eligible to apply.
- Awarded projects will receive the following cleanup resources:
 - Two roll-off containers
 - Trash bags
 - Gloves
 - Loaned out tools





Cleanup Project Justification

The following factors will be considered for project selection:

- What area and/or vulnerable population will benefit?
- What is the community problem for the selected area or population?
- How is the proposed project expected to resolve given issues?
- How will cleanup results be maintained following implementation?





Cleanup Project Examples

- Residential property cleanups to benefit senior citizens, or another vulnerable population, within a designated neighborhood.
- Partnering with a local non-profit, or other civic organization, to cleanup a non-City operated community park or other outdoor space.





Project Selection Process

Neighborhood Cleanup Program application is released.

Tues, Sept 5th

ESD holds application workshop for potential applicants.

Thurs, Sept 7th

Complete application is submitted by each applicant.

Fri, Sept 15th

Applications are evaluated by an ESD review panel.

Neighborhood cleanup projects are implemented

Sat, Oct 21st

Neighborhood Captains and Co-Captains attend mandatory training.

Tues, Oct 17th

Applicants are notified of awarded projects.

Fri, Sept 29th
