## Implementation Roadmap

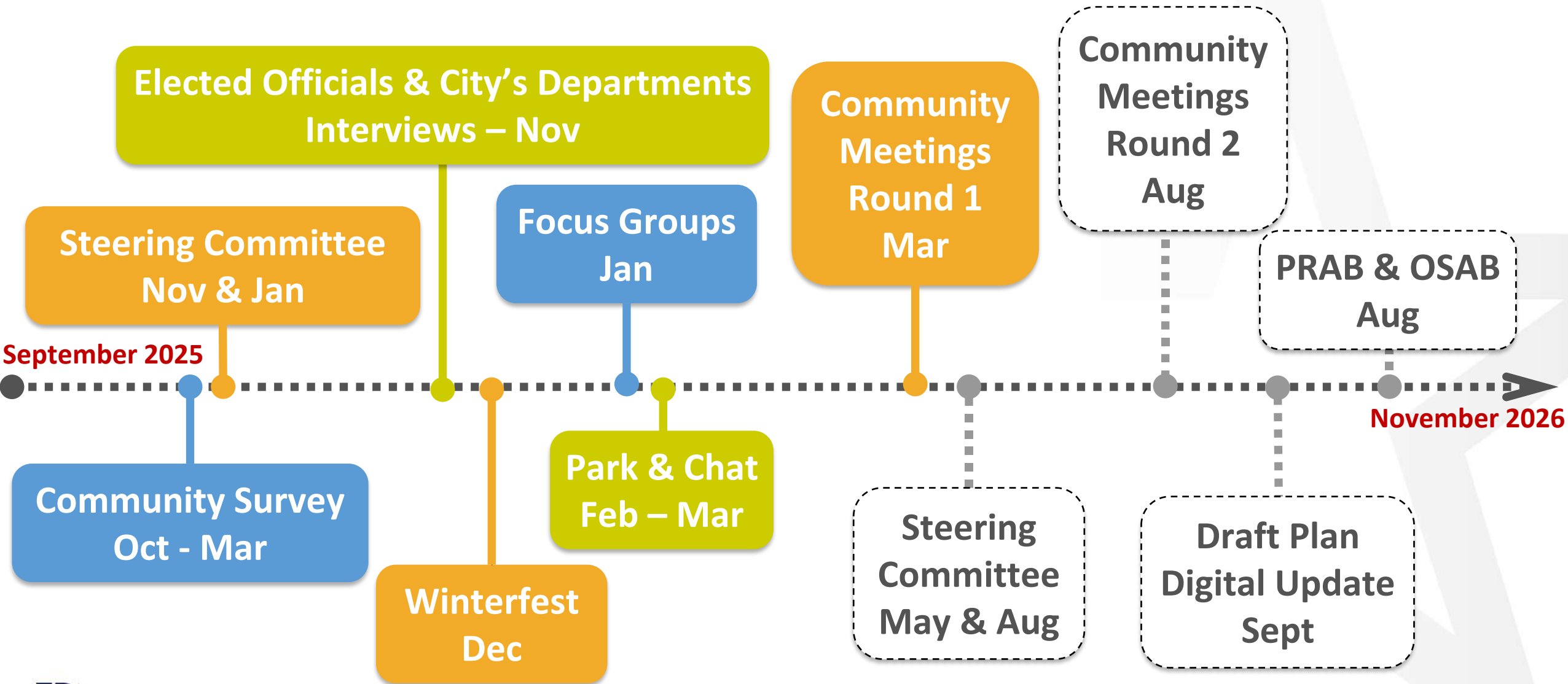
Short-term wins + long-range build-out prioritized by community needs and resources
