SUBJECT:

City Council's Commercial Fuel Card Review from January 1 – April 30, 2023

At the request of the City Council, the Internal Audit Office conducted a review of Commercial Fuel Card usage by members of the City Council from January 1–April 30, 2023. This engagement was accepted based on the engagement's potential to improve management of risks, add value, and/or improve the organization's operations (IIA 2010.C1). The work performed does not constitute an engagement conducted in accordance with <u>Generally Accepted Government Auditing Standards</u> (GAS 1.16). The observations and conclusions that are reported in this memorandum do not require Management Responses.

The Internal Audit Office was able to obtain DK Convenience Store's Purchase Activity Reports from January 1–April 30, 2023 for every City Council District. A detailed analysis was completed for each City Council District. A monthly analysis is included as an attachment to this memorandum. Listed below is the recap of our analysis for the period of January 1–April, 30, 2023.

CITY MANAGER Tommy Gonzalez According to Police Report #23101073 obtained from the El Paso Police Department, it states that District 3 Representative drives a 2020 White Honda Odyssey Van. The District 3 Representative's spouse drives a 2022 Gray Toyota Tacoma Pickup. Based on our analysis of the 10 Security Videos obtained, a White Van is identified 5 times and a Gray Truck is identified 4 times. We were unable to identify the type of vehicle 1 time.

We are able to identify the District 3 Representative 1 time and her spouse 3 times purchasing fuel. Therefore, we can provide reasonable assurance that the vehicles identified belong to the District 3 Representative or her spouse.

OBSERVATION 2 - City Council District 3 Fuel Purchases

For the period of January-April 2023, City Council District 3 purchased 517.49 gallons of fuel in 31 transactions at a cost of \$1,583.87. The amount of fuel purchased based as a percentage of the entire City Council increased from 35.19% in Calendar Year 2022 to 39.91% in 2023 (January-April).

Cassandra Hernandez Based on the frequency of visits to the DK Convenience Stores and the amount of fuel purchased, the data indicates 2 or more vehicles were being fueled. The amount of fuel purchased by District 3 for a period of January-April 2023 appears excessive.

Conclusion:

Based on our review of the DK Convenience Stores' Purchase Activity Reports for January-April 2023 and the 10 Store Security videos obtained, we have determined that 31 fuel purchases were completed during the period of January-April 2023 for City Council District 3. We can provide reasonable assurance that District 3 Representative's and her spouse's vehicles were fueled during the review period.









City Council & City Manager's Office P-Card, Travel, and Fuel Card Review P2023-06 Fuel Usage Summary from January 2023 to April 2023
