At the City Council Meeting of May 11, 2023, the City Council requested that the Internal Audit Office conduct additional work on the City Council's Commercial Fuel Card use for Calendar Year 2020 & 2021. This engagement was accepted based on the engagement's potential to improve management of risks, add value, and/or improve the organization's operations (IIA 2010.C1). The work performed does not constitute an engagement conducted in accordance with Generally Accepted Government Auditing Standards (GAS 1.16). The observations and conclusions that are reported in this memorandum do not require Management Responses.

City Council's Commercial Fuel Card Review for Calendar Year 2020

The Internal Audit Office was able to obtain the DK Convenience Store's Purchase Activity Reports from January 1 - December 31, 2020 for every City Council District. A detailed analysis was completed for each City Council District. A monthly analysis is included as an attachment to this memorandum. Listed below is a recap of our analysis for the period of January 1 – December 31, 2020.



# Results and Conclusion

**OBSERVATION 1 – City Council District 3 Fuel Purchases** 

For the period of January-December 2020, City Council District 3 purchased 979.907 gallons of fuel in 57 transactions at a cost of \$1,751.81. The amount of fuel purchased represents 28.31% of the total amount of fuel purchased by the entire City Council in Calendar Year 2020. This amount was the highest percentage amongst the entire City Council.

Footnote 1 - From January 2020 to December 2020, the billing cycle consisted of the 16th of the previous month to the 15th of the current month.

The El Paso Police Report #23101073 dated April 11, 2023, stated that City Council District 3 Representative drives a 2020 Honda Odyssey. According to an Internet Search, a 2020 Honda Odyssey holds 19.5 gallons of fuel. The Police Report also states that City Council District 3's husband drives a 2022 Toyota Tacoma, which holds 21.1 gallons of fuel. This analysis consists of 2020 fuel data, which indicates the 2022 Toyota Tacoma was not involved. In 2020, the 2022 Toyota Tacoma had not been built yet. Therefore, we can conclude there is a possibility of a 3<sup>rd</sup> vehicle being involved.

### **OBSERVATION 2 – City Council District 6 Fuel Purchases**

For the period of January–December 2020, City Council District 6 purchased 848.945 gallons of fuel in 50 transactions at a cost of \$1,671.98. The amount of fuel purchased represents 27.02% of the total amount of fuel purchased by the entire City Council in Calendar Year 2020. This amount was the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest percentage amongst the entire City Council for Calendar Year 2020.

During our analysis, we also identified the following:

• On July 9, 2020, a purchase of 11.338 gallons of fuel was conducted at a gas station in Pecos, TX. We were unable to determine the reason for this fuel purchase in Pecos, TX.

Based on our analysis of District 6 Fuel Purchases, we can determine that 3 different types of fuel were purchased. Which leads us to believe that there is a possibility of multiple vehicles being fueled.

### Conclusion:

Based on our review of the 2020 Commercial Fuel Card Data obtained from the DK Convenience Stores, we have determined:

- There is a possibility of a 3<sup>rd</sup> vehicle being fueled using the Commercial Fuel Card issued to District 3.
- The different types of fuel being purchased by District 6 indicates a possibility of multiple vehicles being fueled. A fuel purchase of 11.388 gallons was conducted in Pecos, TX on July 9, 2020. We were unable to locate a City Travel Request Forms to Pecos, TX or any other location during July 9, 2020 for City Council District 6.






City Council & City Manager's Office P-Card, Travel, and Fuel Card Review P2023-06 Fuel Usage Summary from January 2020 to December 2020
