COMMUNITY POLICING STORY

DATE: April 14, 2021

On April 14, CRCC PAR coordinated a joint bar check operation with Code Enforcement officers, Health inspectors, and Fire officials in the Five Points area. This was before the Police Department began conducting bar checks in all of the entertainment districts. PAR was beginning to hear about noise complaints from the community, and the unit knew that bar checks should be conducted due to businesses opening to full capacity again after quarantine restrictions. While bar owners were informed of any violations, PAR reminded the owners about the new noise ordinance. The bar owners and managers appreciated that they went in the daytime hours during the work week so that it gave them time to fix things before their busy hours at night and on the weekend. PAR wants to work with businesses due to the hit they took during the pandemic, while also making sure their patrons are safe and businesses are in compliance.
