<u>Certain mosquito repellent products</u>* as a Medicaid benefit for the prevention of Zika virus.

Who is Covered?

Women ages 10- 45 and pregnant women who are enrolled in the following programs:

- Medicaid
- Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)
- CHIP– Perinatal
- Healthy Texas Women



Eligible women can get up to two cans per month through Oct. 31, 2016

Benefit Details

- Eligible patients no longer need to call or visit their doctor for a prescription for mosquito repellent.
- Eligible women can get up to two cans per month.*
- This benefit will end October 31, 2016.
- Mosquito repellent will not count against the monthly 3 prescription limit for those clients with a monthly limit.
- Repellent will be provided at no cost to Medicaid clients.
- CHIP members may pay the generic copay or less, if the cost of the repellent is less than the copay.

*Supply may vary by location

How to Get Repellent

Step 1

Contact your favorite pharmacy to make sure they are participating in this benefit. If you are enrolled in an Managed Care Organization (MCO), please refer to that MCO's website, or call the Member Services number on the back of your Member ID card.

Step 2

Go to your pharmacy and pick up your mosquito repellent. You do not need to obtain a prescription for the repellent, there is an automatic standing order for eligible patients.
