It is the policy of the City of El Paso to ensure no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any department programs or activities.

Any person who believes they have been subjected to unlawful discriminatory practices under Title VI has the right to file a formal complaint. Any such complaint must be filed in writing or in person with the City's Title VI Compliance Coordinator within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory action.
