City to Assist Vulnerable Population

Funding Available for Nonprofit Service Providers to Benefit Low-to-Moderate Income Residents

El Paso, Texas— The City of El Paso has released a Notice of Availability (NOFA) for nonprofit agencies, non-municipal government entities and City departments to address homelessness, provide social service programs, propose public facility improvements and housing rehabilitation that benefit low-to-moderate income residents in our community.

Funding proposals are for the 2023-2024 Federal and State Community Vulnerabilities Funding program year which begins on September 1, 2023.

The specific grants and amounts for funding are:

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG): \$6,154,192
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG): \$542,579
- Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA): \$704,106
- Homeless Housing and Services Program (HHSP): \$432,397

Proposed projects are funded through Federal and State entitlement grants administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA).

Applications and proposals are due by 5 p.m. MST February 21, 2023.
