## City of El Paso Parks and Recreation Gets Ready for Spring Excitment

Municipal Rose Garden Reopens; Scenic Sundays Updates Hours

**El Paso, Texas**— The Parks and Recreation Department is excited to welcome spring with the reopening of the El Paso Municipal Rose Garden and updating the spring/summer hours for Scenic Sundays on Scenic Drive.

## El Paso Municipal Rose Garden

The Municipal Rose Garden, 1702 N. Copia, is now open daily from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. through November 30. The garden is closed during recognized City holidays.

The four-acre garden is home to more than 1,400 rose bushes of more than 430 different rose varieties. In addition to roses, the outdoor facility has waterfalls, walking paths, benches and a Koi fishpond that make for a soothing experience. Visiting the garden is free to the public.

El Paso Master Gardener volunteers prune, deadhead, remove weeds, provide rose inventories, and perform other tasks to keep the garden beautiful and enjoyable for the community.

## **Scenic Sundays Spring/Summer Hours**

Beginning Sunday, April 1 the hours for Scenic Sundays will be 6 to 11 a.m. for the spring and summer season.

Scenic Sundays promote health and wellness in the community by closing vehicular access to Scenic Drive between Wheeling and Robinson, allowing visitors to walk, run, cycle or skateboard, while enjoying the stunning views of El Paso and Ciudad Juarez.
