Residents Invited to Share Priorities for FY 2026 Budget

Chime In! Survey Now Open

In addition to the community meetings, the City has officially launched its annual **Chime In! survey**, a key component of its public engagement efforts to involve residents in the budget development process. The survey is **now open** and gives residents and businesses a direct way to share which services matter most to them—and how they'd like to see their tax dollars put to work.

Survey results will help City leaders prioritize funding decisions and shape the FY 2026 operating budget around the services most valued by the community.

These outreach efforts follow the City's Strategic Budget Development Workshop held in March, which provided a foundation for aligning financial priorities with Council goals and community needs.
