The new garden will serve as a green hub for the neighborhood, providing opportunities to grow fresh produce, participate in educational workshops, and strengthen community connections through shared outdoor experiences.

"This community garden is more than just a place to grow plants—it's a place to grow community," said Parks and Recreation Director Pablo Caballero. "On National Arbor Day, we're reminded of the powerful role that green spaces play in creating a healthier, more connected city."

In addition to the community garden, the **FREE** Arbor Day celebration will feature planting activities, guest speakers, live performances, food vendors, informational booths, and more.
