City to Host Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony for Fire Station No. 16 Renovations

WHERE: Fire Station No. 16, 3828 Hercules Avenue

The City of El Paso is hosting a ribbon cutting to celebrate renovations to Fire Station No. 16 in Northeast El Paso.

This fire station supporting fire protection and emergency response received the following improvements:

- Renovations to the interior and exterior of the facility
- Upgrades to HVAC, electrical and plumbing systems
- Condition site improvements to the parking lot
- Installation of ADA compliant parking space, sidewalks and ramps
- New windows, ceiling, doors, floor tile and a new coat of paint for the facility
- New decontamination room and personal protective equipment storage

This marks the 13th project completed under the voter-approved 2019 Public Safety Bond, which has contributed more than \$61 million in community investment to date.

The bond provides critical funding to renovate and build new emergency response facilities, enabling the Fire and Police Departments to deliver exceptional service and enhance public safety across El Paso.

The Fire Station No. 16 Renovation Project, with an approximate budget of \$1.89 million, reflects the City of El Paso's continued commitment to strengthening public safety operations and maintaining its reputation as one of the safest cities in the nation.
